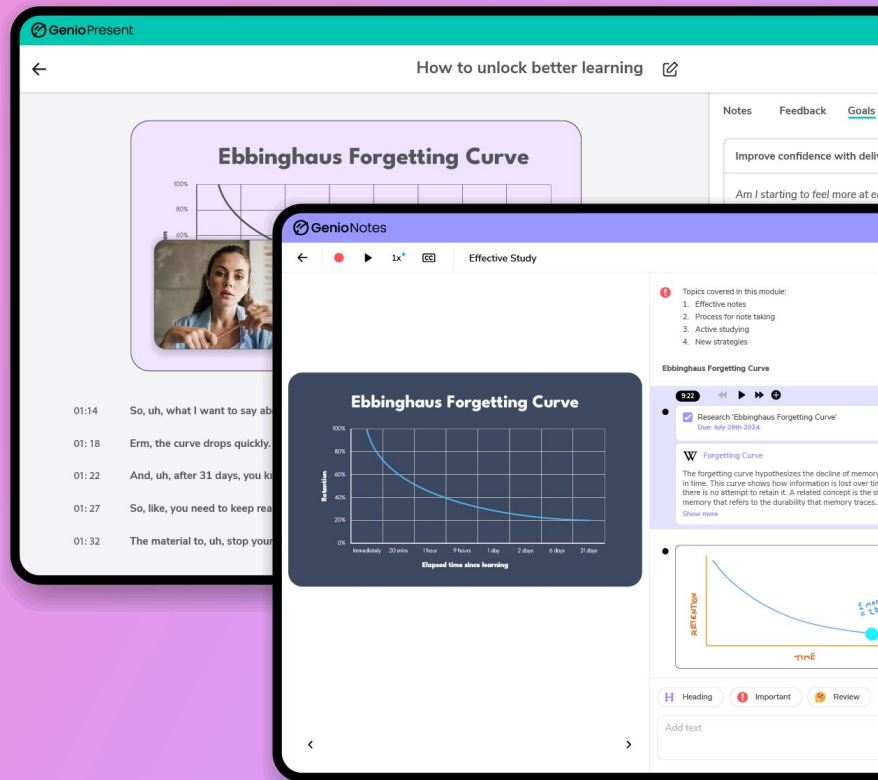

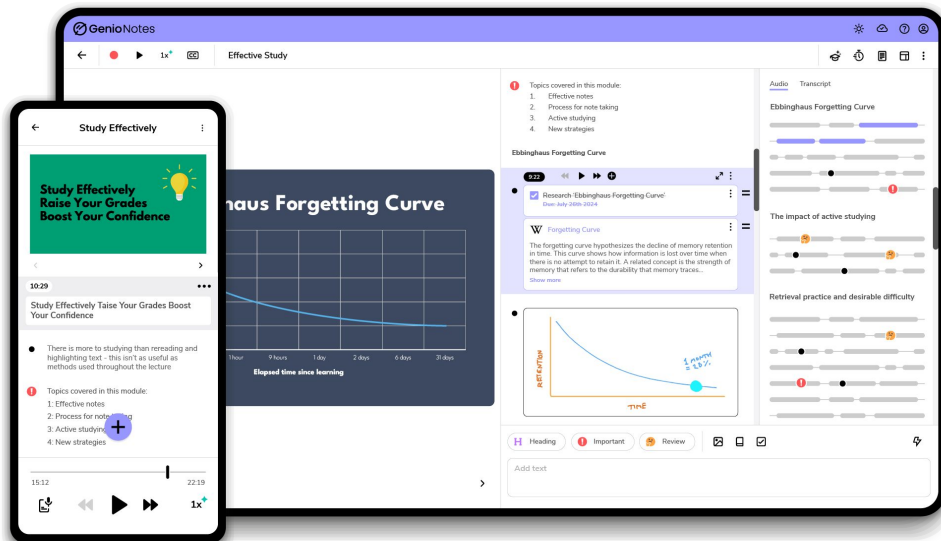

Transcribe audio, generate an outline of topics, & organise notes into collections.

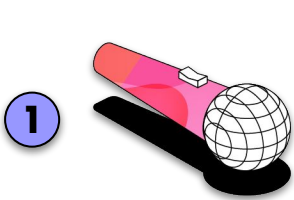
